The Challenge is on:

- Pledges/Donations you collect will help to support rehabilitation services in Saskatchewan.
- The relay provides an inclusive opportunity for everyone to participate by wheeling in wheelchairs and join together for fundraising, public awareness and a whole lot of fun!

About Spinal Cord Injuries and Other Physical Disabilities:

- Approximately 86,000 Canadians experience paralysis due to a spinal cord injury.
- 4,300 new permanent injuries occur annually in Canada.
- The majority of new injuries are experienced by men 16-30 years of age.
- Motor vehicle accidents, falls, work and sports related incidents remain the most frequent causes of spinal cord injury.
- Most common disabilities are related to pain, flexibility and mobility.

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Team Captain Information

Team Captains are one of the main reasons for the Relay's success. We rely on captains to coordinate their team, distribute the appropriate supplies and information, and motivate your team to collect as many pledges as possible. Recruit a Team of four (4) people, and encourage them to complete the pledge tasks.

As Team Captain, it is your responsibility to do the following:

- Register your team.
- Distribute pledge/donations envelopes, and informational packages to all team members.
- Ensure that team members record all information correctly. Receipts will only be provided for pledges \$20 or greater.
- Ensure your team collects a minimum of \$200 in pledges/donations.
- Submit each team member's donations/pledges and their pledge sheets.
- Ensure that all team members complete the participant waiver forms and provide them to SCI Sask before the relay day.
- Collect all pledge/donation envelopes from your team members and deliver them to the SCI Sask office by Friday September 20 2019 at 4:30pm to be eligible for pledge-related prizes. Pledges can also be dropped off at the Relay Registration table on September 21 2019 however these pledges will not go towards prizes.
