Contribution Levels

Event Contributor: Commit to a \$5,000 contribution

- Recognition throughout the day that all donations up to \$5,000 will be matched by your company.

Gold Contributor: Commit to a \$2,500 contribution

Silver Contributor: Commit to a \$1,250 contribution

Receive 2 x Hot Call interviews the day of the event

Bronze Contributor: Commit to a \$500 contribution

Receive one Hot Call interview the day of the event

Community Contributor: Commit to a \$250 contribution

- Receive name mention 10 times throughout the Day of Giving as a Community Contributor
